



Dendrobium Section Rhizobium Hybrids & Species F40 D. Waverley Delight x D. teretifolium 'Shane' D. Waverly Delight has a lovely shape and is of burnt orange and sunset tones. D. teretifolium 'Shane' is an excellent example of the species with its cream flowers, more significant than normal. Hopefully, these produce lots of large colourful flowers. Available in 50mm @ \$8 G43 D. Tweetas 'Neville' x D. Martin 'Gold' HCC/AOC This is one cross I have very high hopes for. D. Tweetas 'Neville' has excellent shape and colour, paired here with the 'beefy' D. Martin 'Gold'. We are looking for colourful yellows and oranges with a unique shape. There's no experimentation with this cross, just on a hunt for award quality progeny. Available in 50mm @ \$8 & 80mm @ \$15 2977 D. Australian Ginger 'Wow' HCC/ANOS-AOC AD/AOC x D. Kalon Byrne-Dimos 'Newbold' Again, large and colourful flowers are expected. However, we are hoping to maintain the quality shape and proportioned nature of the clear yellow 'Newbold'. The ginger used in this cross might not have the best shape of the grex, but what it does have is colour. Available in 50mm @ \$8 2978 D. Tweetas 'Curly Gold' x D. Wickersham 'Genesis' The next generation of yellow hybrids here, looking for purple tones in the labellum and full shape. We used 'Curly Gold' because of its floriferousness and also compact growth habit. 'Genesis' is of course the product of D. Lauren 'Holly Chief' AM/AOC Available in 50mm @ \$8 3011 D. Tweetie 'Huge' x D. Australian Ginger 'Big Guy' Searching for big and colourful flowers similar to D. Tweetas, however this time with an extra dose of *D. fuliginosum*. 'Big Guy' is our largest ginger and has an awesome ruffled labellum. These should be good. Available in 50mm @ \$8 3012 D. Tweetie 'Pie' x D. Martin 'Gold' HCC/AOC The 'beefy' D. Martin 'Gold' has very good shape and it also has an interesting mix of green and gold tones. Here we have match him with 'Pie' to try and achieve a different colouration. Also, by using D. Tweetie there is a chance we will get more than one flowering a year. These should be plants for the show bench. Available in 50mm @ \$8 3013 D. Sharday = D. chordiforme 'Tumbi' x D. Tweetie 'Pie' The reason I made this cross was to begin a line of breeding, a line of compact plants that flower in the later months of the year, this way we have section rhizobium hybrids in flower all year round. We expect quality shape and colours ranging from yellow to red. Available in 50mm @ \$8





3120 D. teretifolium var. aureum 'Gigantor' HCC/AOC x D. Martin 'Royal'

Similar to cross 3121. We have added 'Gigantor' to the mix with its massive blooms and an average of 9 flowers per inflorescence. We have also learnt that 'Gigantor' intensifies colour, with our cross *D*. Hunter Legend.

2972 D. teretifolium var. teretifolium 'Buddha' x self

This particular clone has very thick terete leaves and large flowers. The more of this beautiful species we can make available, the less they might 'disappear' from nature. Will grow best mounted on hardwood or cork.

3138 D. Burgundy Bride 'Dell' x D. Yondi Tina 'Goliath' FCC/AOC

After catching up with David Butler, I decided to remake this cross that he had made back in 2003. You may wonder why 16 years later. Well, it seems that there are not many mature plants of this cross around and as David said "The flowers of 'Dell' had an attractive dark edging but most striking (in the mind of this tooth-picker) was the gorgeous full purple labellum which I was sure would be reproduced in its progeny". So, with YTG some interesting seedling should appear. **6.3%** *bigibbum*

3141 D. Gundy Sun 'Shinning' x D. Candice 'Yellow/Purple'

'Yellow/Purple' has achieved awesome things with the D. Bergen remakes. So, I decided to introduce it to the D. Burgundy Cream line. I guess this is somewhat a stepping stone cross. It may unlock potential or... it may not. A bit like every cross haha. Anyway, I have hopes of cream/yellow flowers with vibrant pink markings. **6.3%** bigibbum

3142 D. Touch of Class 'Dark' x D. spec. var. spec. 'Windermere'

As Tropicool Dendrobium breeding become more complex, I believe it is crucial to reintroduce vigorous and easily grown hybrids or species. So, here I used the ever faithful 'Windermere' to increase flower count, strengthen the inflorescence and make the plants more robust. We may lose a little colour, but we might not. **6.3%** *bigibbum*

3144/48 D. Jonathon's Glory 'Dark Joy' HCC/AOC x D. Tyabb

Here we are looking for compact plants, with great colour and shape. We expect long inflorescences above the foliage of these plants and they should flower on small plants. The *D.* Tyabb used, has substance and texture plus and a great shape. **6.3%** *bigibbum*

3009 D. Yarra Quartz 'Frank Lowe' x D. spec. var. spec. 'Windermere'

This cross was made by Peter Adams. Many growers from NSW and Queensland will not have seen these plants which are of extremely high quality. With percentages of *D. kingianum*, *D. speciosum*, *D. fleckeri*, *D. jonesii and D. gracilicaule* this will provide a refreshing alternative to all our collections.




3152 D. Aussie Victory x D. Jazz 'Windsor Downs'




2996 D. kingianum 'Dark Vovo' x D. kingianum '#29'


Two of our best dark *D. kingianum's*. Searching for a new batch of dark kingie's with improved shape, flower count and size.
