





Dendrobium Section Rhizobium Hybrids & Species F40 D. Waverley Delight x D. teretifolium 'Shane' D. Waverly Delight has wonderful shape and is of burnt orange and sunset tones. D. teretifolium 'Shane' is a fine example of the species with its cream flowers, larger than normal. Hopefully these flower with lots of colour and lots of large flowers. Available in 50mm @ \$8 & 80mm @ \$15 G43 D. Tweetas 'Neville' x D. Martin 'Gold' HCC/AOC This is one cross I personally have very high hopes for. D. Tweetas 'Neville' has excellent shape and colour, paired here with the 'beefy' D. Martin 'Gold'. We are looking for colourful yellows and oranges with outstanding shape. There's no experimentation with this cross, just on a hunt for award quality Available in 50mm @ \$8 & 80mm @ \$15 JD1313 D. Australian Ginger 'Golly' FCC/AOC-ANOS x D. teretifoium var. aureum 'JD Gold' Another from our southern friend Jeanne Dunn, whose hybridisation is nothing short of outstanding. This is a reverse of 2833 and its parents are actually very similar. These should be a large flower, packed with colour and thanks to the influence of *D. striolatum* the plants shouldn't grow meters long! Available in 50mm @ \$8 2977 D. Australian Ginger 'Wow' HCC/ANOS-AOC AD/AOC x D. Kalon Byrne-Dimos 'Newbold' Again, large and colourful flowers are expected. However, we are hoping to maintain the quality shape and proportioned nature of the clear yellow 'Newbold'. The ginger used in this cross might not have the best shape of the grex, but what it does have is colour. Available in 50mm @ \$8 2978 D. Tweetas 'Curly Gold' x D. Wickersham 'Genesis' The next generation of yellow hybrids here, looking for purple tones in the labellum and full shape. We used 'Curly Gold' because of its floriferousness and also compact growth habit. 'Genesis' is of course the product of D. Lauren 'Holly Chief' AM/AOC Available in 50mm @ \$8 2989 D. Harmon 'Mark' x D. Hot Coals Our mushroom pinkish-brown Harmon is a relatively large *Dendrobium*, its white striations and its 30mm plus wide bloom really stand out in spring. It's a very compact plant and its inflorescences are completely upright. We used *D*. Hot Coals to hopefully inject a fair amount of its brown and red colouration, just for something a bit different. Available in 50mm @ \$8 3011 D. Tweetie 'Huge' x D. Australian Ginger 'Big Guy' Searching for big and colourful flowers similar to D. Tweetas, however this time with an extra dose of *D. fuliginosum*. 'Big Guy' is our largest ginger and has an awesome ruffled labellum. These should be good. Available in 50mm @ \$8







3127 D. Tweetas 'Old Gold' x D. Grey Ghost 'Tumbi' AM/AOC-ANOS

Probably my favourite cross in the 2019 catalogue. I'm really excited about the colour prospects of this cross as it could potentially unlock a brand-new colour or combination. We have seen D. Grey Ghost do this before, creating stunning blue wash colours. Both plants are compact, floriferous, have great colour and

2971 D. teretifolium var. teretifolium 'Bega' x 'Buddha'

A cross of a white D. teretifolium given to us by the late Brian Abbott with 'Bega' our largest white! This particular clone has very thick terete leaves and large flowers. The more of this beautiful species we can make available, the less they might 'disappear' from nature. Will grow best mounted on hardwood

JC1000 D. striolatum 'Alba Packer's' x 'Tassie Gold'

This cross was made by Jody Cutajar. We have a few excess plants so thought we would make them available as everyone loves a good *D. striolatum*. These will be varying intensities of yellow, maybe a few albas.

G52 D. Bergen 'Melissa' x D. Zip 'JMCM'

We have been struggling to get germination with this spectacular *D*. Bergen, so I gave in and put the ever-fruitful D. Zip on to 'Melissa'. I guess this is seen as a stepping stone hybrid but the results should be some heavily patterned white flowers that are very strong growers. 3% bigibbum

G57 D. Burgundy Bride 'Dell' x D. Sunglow 'Tumbi'

'Dell' hosts a bold burgundy labellum matched by maroon patterning on the segments and this labellum seems to carry through into its progeny. Therefore, we paired it with our best *D.* Sunglow which is known to let colour through. Maybe just maybe we will see some yellows with red labellum's. 6.3% bigibbum





G61 D. Gillieston Jazz 'Fishing Point' x D. Finale 'Chunks'

We are trying to gain intensity of colour, substance and ease of growth in this cross. The vibrant pinks and purples of 'Fishing Point' would look better on a vellow background and improvements to shape are always a bonus. 12.5% biaibbum



There's nothing better than a compact plant that flowers its head off every spring and this is just what this cross will do. They may not be award winners but they will be colourful. 6.3% bigibbum Available in 50mm @\$8 F61 D. Jayden = D. Elegant Heart 'Sundowner' x D. speciosum 'Top Shelf' Bernie Fletcher has remade D. Jayden for us, using a particular D. Elegant
	Heart which is absolutely massive in size and which carries an equally impressive labellum. It's not often you see quality remakes of this hybrid done by someone of Bernie's calibre. 12.5% bigibbum Available in 50mm @ \$8
WAXANCE DINON	G62 D. Gillieston Jazz 'Fishing Point' x D. Zip 'JMCM'
	We know <i>D</i> . Zip should not be under estimated just yet, it has this magic ability to give us fantastic striping. The vibrant pinks and purples of 'Fishing Point' would be superior if they were more defined and improvements to shape are always a bonus. 12.5% <i>bigibbum</i> Available in 50mm @ \$8
	As Tropicool Dendrobium breeding become more complex, I believe it is crucial to reintroduce vigorous and easily grown hybrids or species. The late Norm Mitchell gifted me this piece of 'Striker' and I thought thing new mum would take a liking. I am hoping to see dark and large flowers on compact and vigorous plants. 6.3% bigibbum

	G56 D. Burgundy Bride 'Dell' x D. Finale 'Chunks'

		3022 D. spec. ('Clarrie' x 'Larwind') x D. spec. 'Triffid's Moon'
		'Triffid's Moon' is 'Triffid' x 'Daylight Moon' FCC/AOC, and boasts large rounded segments, awesome colour and texture plus. These will be compact growers and should be dark cream/light yellow in colour. Available in 50mm @ \$8
		3023 D. spec. ('Clarrie' x 'Larwind') x D. spec. 'Palm Moon'
		Dad here is a 'Palmerston' x 'Daylight Moon' FCC/AOC, this should produce creams and dark creams of excellent shape on long racemes. Available in 50mm @ \$8
		2996 D. kingianum 'Dark Vovo' x D. kingianum '#29' Two of our best dark D. kingianum's. Searching for a new batch of dark kingie's with improved shape, flower count and size. Available in 50mm @ \$8



Exotic Treasures		
	E14 Stanhopea (bolivavensis x inodora) x Self A selfing of an interesting Stanhopea hybrid, which carries 3-5 large white-based flowers, covered in deep burgundy spots. Available in 80mm @ \$12	
	This epiphyte grows at 4500' on the moist coastal mountains of Brazil. Leaves are short and fleshy but the inflorescences can be 3 to 6 feet tall. A mass of yellow and brown while in bloom. This species won't require heat but may enjoy a hard roof during the cooler months in particular areas. Available in 100mm @ \$18	
	A compact Brazilian species that has beautiful deep yellow flowers with a dark black chocolate mask in the centre and copper/bronze sepals and petals. Likes medium light and growing on a slab of cork. Available in 80mm @ \$15	
	2932 Cattleya tenebrosa These seedlings are from a flask given to us by Phil Spence. We expect them to be the brown form of this showy species that easy to grow. Available in 80mm @ \$15	
	DR100 Cymbidium Dr Len 'Dusky Imp' – Mericlones This plant was the 2012 OSNSW hybrid of the year and has won countless grand champions and champions over recent years and is one of the very cymbidiums we continue to grow to this date. Available in NFS @ \$25	
	PR100 Pleurothallis restrepioides 'Dragonstone'	
	Something a little different that will flower numerous times throughout the year with its long sprays of white and maroon flowers. We grow our specimens in very high light on the <i>D. speciosum</i> bench. Available in 80mm @ \$12	
	Plants produce many inflorescences with an abundance of 2 cm large flowers. In full bloom this plant is a spectacular show plant. This easy to grow species will do well in most conditions with medium levels of light, Available in 50mm @ \$10

	D1 D. Tweetas 'Violet Lip' AM-ACM/AOC HCC-ACC/ANOS The one and only 'Violet Lip', if something is this good why not share it around. It's always good to see others breed with and show something like 'Violet Lip'. Available in 80mm @ \$50 ONE ONLY		
	D2 D. Oliver Jack 'Gerard' FCC/AOC HCC/ANOS The one and only Oliver Jack! if something is this good why not share it around. It's always good to see others breed with and show something like this. Available in 90mm @ \$70 ONE ONLY – FLOWERING SIZE		
	D3 D. striolatum 'Tasmanian Gold' Produces masses of golden coloured blooms on upright growths, we grow ours in a mesh Port Pot & it does well. Available in 80mm @ \$15		
	D4 D. striolatum 'Frills' Similar to 'Frills', good base colour with strong maroon striations and a ruffled labellum. Also, a good and fast grower. Available in 80mm @ \$15		
	D5 D. striolatum 'NSW Gold' ('Ruffles' FCC/AOC x 'Tasmanian Gold') A compact grower that is golden yellow and flowers earlier than all the others. Available in 80mm @ \$15		
	D6 D. striolatum 'Ruffles' FCC/AOC Recently awarded an FCC and an AM earlier in its life, plus Bill Murdoch Silver '04,'05 &'08 certainly a good doer and definite show quality. Available in Bare Root @ \$15
